

Your Rights of Appeal Information

Registrants and or registered organizations who wish to seek leave to appeal a decision will have fourteen (14) days from the date on which they received notice of the decision together with their Rights to Appeal, to submit the following:

- A. Completed Appeal Application Form
- B. Intentions of Appeal
- C. Grounds for appeal
- D. All evidence that supports these grounds, including all documents
- E. The remedy or remedies requested
- F. A copy of the written decision being appealed, or the Appellant's understanding of the decision
- G. A signature of the Appellant or authorized representative of the Appellant
- H. Evidence of payment of any outstanding fees, fines or bonds
- I. Include the Appeal Fee

All decisions made by an ERSL Discipline Hearing Panel relating to misconduct in a Regional level game can be appealed to Ontario Soccer.

Appeals of a league decision must be submitted to Ontario Soccer in accordance with the [OSA Rights of Appeal Information](#). The OSA Application to Appeal form can be found [here](#).

The criteria for the grounds for appeal

The letter of appeal must specify your rationale for appealing the decision of the (Club/League). Your rationale must include:

- a) Making a decision for which the Respondent did not have the authority or jurisdiction as set out in the applicable governing documents;
- b) New facts were not available when the decision was made;
- c) Failing to properly interpret the relevant Published Rules;
- d) Failing to follow procedures as laid out in the relevant Publishes Rules;
- e) Making a decision that was influenced by bias
- f) Alleged excessive fine, fee, bond, or suspension. Failure to provide adequate rationale will result in your appeal being disallowed.
